## Subject: Art

Art stimulates creativity and imagination. It provides visual, tactile and sensory experiences and a special way of understanding and responding to the world. A high-quality art education should inspire, engage and challenge children - enabling pupils to communicate what they see, feel and think through the use of colour, texture, form and pattern.

Children will become involved in shaping their environment through art and design activities, involving different creative techniques. They will explore ideas and meaning through the work of artists and designers. We relish the opportunity for pupils to express themselves creatively throughout the year as opportunities arise and are keen to work with local artists as well as involve Kingsway in local Art competitions. Additionally, as pupils learn about the history, roles and functions of art, they can explore the impact that it has on contemporary life and that of different times and cultures.

Our art and design lessons are taught through a thematic topic approach using the Cornerstones Curriculum. We will inspire our learners to work collaboratively, be critical thinkers and understand everyone can be an artist, therefore, helping our children to progress into confident and competent learners for the future. Pupils sketch books follow them throughout the key stages and are a great example of how pupil's creative confidence grows during their school years spent at Kingsway.

## Aims and Objectives:
